# Fly Creek Clean up Volunteers Needed January 25 & 26 Meet at 8:00 am at Maplewood


Many trees are down and Fly Creek is in dire need of clean up. Erik spoke with Jared of the surveyor's office, and the Army Corps of Engineers has given us permission to proceed with clean up. We will be financially compensated for doing this work. Equipment has been purchased to help with handling the logs, and it will be our responsibility to clear and maintain a path to continue to be able to do this.

Volunteers are needed on January 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to do this work. They will meet at 8:00 am on 1/25 at Maplewood. Bring chainsaws if possible. If you would like some of the wood, bring a truck or trailer.

- The fish stocking committee continues to research solutions for our gizzard shad problem. We will stock Pike and/or Muskie next year, and possibly more Walleye.
- Signs to promote our "catch and release" promotion will be placed around the lakes, and a contest (more details next time!) for pictures of walleye caught and released will take place.
- The DNR will study our lakes next spring in order to advise us on where and how to create more habitats for our fish population.
