WATER LEVEL MAINTENANCE / FLY CREEK CLEARINGS:

First and foremost, Thank You to the few individuals that joined the contact list for Fly Creek clearings so far... Appreciated!

However, we still need more volunteers. Please sign-up if interested. Volunteers will always be contacted first to see if they are available for scheduled clearing days; therefore, you will always have the flexibility to participate only on the days that work for you. We just need a group willing to attempt to gather a day or two, periodically throughout the year, to clear debris.

Clearing the creek is a necessity in maintaining our lake water levels and to avoid flooding. In addition, it is a great way to boost our fish stocking fund, as it has already raised over \$13,000! Sadly, if we do not have enough volunteers, a crew will need to be hired to clear the creek, and they will receive the monies that could have gone into our Fish Stocking fund. 
FAMILY FISHING TOURNAMENTS:




