

**Fish and Royer Lake Association Board Meeting via Zoom Minutes**

**DISCUSSIONS:**

**Fish Structures and Stocking:** Erik P. to host building structures at/near his property on 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in March. Also happening at property of Mark A. and Dave Mc. Tom Mc to contact neighbor Rust Mc regarding concrete blocks for anchorage (approx. 200 needed). Otherwise contact Big C Lumber to order.

**Fly Creek Cleanup:** Jay B., Tom Mc, and Zach (DNR) walked creek from 100 S. to the lake. Jay estimates we would need 4-6 volunteers (est. 6 hours to complete the job). Need to discuss removing large tree with Ron. More work is also needed on creek south of Hwy 20 to 100 S.

**Buoys:** Jim Koza and Jeff Klebe are in charge of maintaining existing buoys. Mark A. to place channel marker buoys (idle speed only).

**Memorial Day:** Fish tourney that day as well as overnight catfishing. It was decided to table a poker run (sponsored by Dave Schnieders) until maybe Labor Day weekend.

**Garage Sale:** Held Father's Day weekend. Endorsement by F/R Association pending.

**Dues:** By-laws say dues must be paid by March 1<sup>st</sup> (31<sup>st</sup>?). Dave Mc said send a should be sent out @ 4 weeks as a notice/reminder. Several options were presented to encourage (early/timely) payment.

**Fish Stocking:** Motion made by Erik P. to purchase/place 1,800 walleye, 600 northern pike and 1,800 smallmouth bass this year.
