


Association Hog Roast Meeting & Election:

- IDEM has been contacted regarding water runoff, specifically observed at inlet ditch at the N.E. corner of Fish Lake.
- Fish stocking reduces gizzard shad populations which results in reduced turbidity of lake(s) water.
- Trees and turf uprooted by last June's wind storm will remain as they are.

2021 Topic: The Importance of Indiana's Wetlands

Entry must be a 300 word, essay on why Indiana's wetlands are environmentally important. It must contain an introduction, a body and a conclusion. Be sure to cite any sources used for specifics, statistics, quotations, or arguable information.

Essay entries must include a cover letter indicating the writer's name, address and phone number, the name of the college or school attending, a copy of their fall semester schedule or acceptance letter, and the name of the paid Association Member to whom they are related.

Emailed entries must be submitted to Mark Albert at mendyandmark@live.com, before July 31st. The chosen scholarship winner will be notified by August 10th. Public announcement will be made at the annual meeting August 28th; as well as posted on the lake's media pages.



Safe Mosquito Alternatives:

Lemon Grass plants are excellent container plants, and setting one by your front door is a lovely way to welcome guests into your home. The plant gives off a slight lemony fragrance, but that alone will not be enough to keep pesky



mosquitoes from entering your home uninvited. The best and most effective way to repel mosquitoes using the plant is to crush the leaves, thus releasing the oil, and rub them directly onto your skin. Even so, this method will only repel mosquitoes for a short time.

Baobab Body Butter Traditionally baobab is used to treat asthma, anemia and fever. It is also mixed with water and used as a rub for



treating skin allergies and mosquito bites. To use as a mosquito repellent, apply the body butter to exposed areas of skin and massage in. Be prepared. This body butter smells really strong at first, but the scent will mellow after approximately 5-10 minutes.

Vitamin B1 If one is sensitive to harsh chemicals and/or smells, taking Vitamin B is a great alternative from DEET products.

Lawn Fertilizers / Weed killers: All companies are legally obligated to share their ingredient list with you. Though they may claim they are environmentally safe for bodies of water, fish, animals, children or our pollinators, they often at times are not indeed safe. Always investigate a bit further than the surface. You may be surprised what you find!

Remember To: Keep gutters and all containers empty of debris and standing water, empty and change bird baths water weekly, and keep tall grass and weed cut down.
